As to be recalled, by our stated dated 20.08.2010 we had made public that the part of 4.435.803,-TL of the cases filed for the cancellation of the tax/fine notifications amounting to a total of 30.895.416,-TL served to our Company related to the fiscal terms 2004, 2005 and 2006, have resulted against us; that the Tax Department has sent to our Company tax/fine notifications amounting to a total of 7.311.476,-TL including the default interest and the judgment fee and that this amount (7.311.476,-TL) is payable until September 3rd, 2010 and that the necessary legal pleas related to the appeal of the cases with the superior court shall be realized in due time.

The entire notifications sent by the Tax Department (7.311.476,-TL) have been paid on 26.08.2010 due to the end of the period of notice.

The payment having been effected, the objection made by our Company has also been deemed appropriate, and the enforcement of the part of 6.195.422,-TL of the tax/fine notification [our request for stopping the enforcement related to the remaining part of 1.116.054 TL has not been concluded yet] has been stopped. In the award of the Council of State related to the subject, which has been taken delivery of during the evening hours today, the following has been stated: "It has been unanimously decided on 20.09.2010 to stop the enforcement, without seeking any security, until receiving the reply of the defendant Administration to the appeal or until giving of a new judgment upon the lapse of the time for entering the reply, according to the legal nature of the circumstance and dispute explained in the Petition of Appeal." The judgment of the said case based on the merits is continued separately.
